
The Relays

- **Main role** Being the **link** between the ReD Managers and the PhD candidates of each doctoral college (can be several PhDs/college)
- Main tasks
 - Relay ReD's information bring up issues from PhD candidates
 - Act as a person of reference for PhDs
 - Contribute to social & scientific exchanges within the college
- **Meetings** Once or twice a year with the Coordination Manager; the rest is up to you!
- Degree of involvement Medium

Current relays/college:








The Members

- Main role Getting involved in the network, in any way you would like to!
- Main tasks
 - Help organise an event; and/or
 - Get involved in a working group!
- Meetings Once a month +- for the working groups;
 several ones before an event
- Degree of involvement Low to medium








The Delegates

- Main role Intermediate between member and manager
- Main tasks
 - Working group Delegate: be aware of the projects conducted in the WG and report them to the Project Manager;
 - Social Media Delegate: take care of a specific social media and coordinate with the others + the Communication Manager;
 - Web Media Delegate: maintain the ReD website
 - **Event Delegate**: organise a *participative* event
- **Meetings** Once a month on average
- **Degree of involvement** Medium to high







The Managers

- Main role Be the main actors of the network and coordinate globally the activities and projects
- Main tasks
 - Coordination: ensure good communication with the PhDs through the relays
 - Project: supervise the working group delegates
 - Communication: ensure a good functioning and coordination within the communication delegates
 - **Finances**: deal with the university subsidies, making sure to allocate them equally
 - Public Relation: be the face and voice of the ReD
 - Secretary: ensure efficient administrative practises within the network




Doctorate Working Group






International Working Group


